Ming's executive career spanned real estate, investment management, media and finance. She spent 11 years at Investa Property Group where she held several roles including joint Managing Director, Chief Financial Officer, and Group Executive, IOF Fund Manager, leading a ASX listed fund with a market capitalisation of \$2.5bn. She was the first woman of an Asian heritage to lead an ASX 100 or 200 entity.
